Those who intend to complete the FAFSA online must have an electronic Personal Identification Number (PIN). The pin number can be obtained online prior to filing at www.pin.ed.gov, or can be obtained online at the Financial Aid Marathon. Both the parent and the student will need a PIN in order to sign and complete the FAFSA. Those who intend to complete the FAFSA at the Financial Aid Marathon should be sure to bring:

- 1 A copy of student and parent 2009 completed Federal taxes - 1040, 1040a, 1040ez and 2009 W-2 forms. If the tax forms have not been completed, numbers can be estimated for the FAFSA using the W-2, if necessary.
- 2 Any other income, including Social Security benefits.
- 3 Statements of the student's and parent's balances of checking, savings and cash on hand.
- 4 Statements showing the value of investments such as stocks and bonds.
- 5 Both the student and parent birth dates and social security numbers.
