WINTER IS COMING!! Are Your Children Ready?

Not only are the leaves falling but the temperatures are falling rapidly each day. The mornings are often colder than the rest of the day. It is important our students come to school warmly dressed.

The Olive School Staff also requests parents do not drop their children off at school before 7:10 AM for breakfast or 7:20 AM (CST) for school. Many mornings are already cold and uncomfortable for children to wait outdoors until the doors open. We have some students being dropped off at school as early as 45-60 min. before school. The school staff are not on duty for student supervision and crossing assistance until 7:10 AM (CST). Students who are dropped off at school before this time are not only waiting out in the cold but are doing so in an unsupervised situation.

Even though the temperatures in the mornings have been below freezing many students are still coming to school in sweatshirts and t-shirts. Children need to be dressed for the weather since they go outside for recess as well as arrival and dismissal. If your child does not have a warm coat, hat, or gloves and you cannot afford to get them, please let the school know and we will try to assist you.

During the fall months, students need to wear a coat and hat to school each day. During winter months the students need to come to school in warm coats, hats, gloves, boots and snow pants (extra pair of pants). Please make sure your child is warmly dressed and ready for outside recess each day this fall and winter.

We want to keep our students warm, safe, and learning. Thank you for your support.
