Message from the Principal

Our Spring testing required by the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) will take place this year for our third, fourth, and fifth grade students. Third grade students will be the first group to test by taking the IREAD3 assessment. Testing is online and is usually administered in the morning session of the school day over a three to four day time period. The timeframe set by the IDOE for third graders to complete this assessment begins March 8 and ends March 19, 2021. We will send out our exact testing dates as we move closer to this time. ILEARN is taken by all third, fourth, and fifth grade students beginning April 19. We will also send out our testing schedule as we approach this timeframe. Additional information regarding IREAD3 and ILEARN assessments can be found online at www.doe.in.gov. Classroom teachers will be sending home information regarding specific testing schedules (dates and times), so be sure to check your child's weekly folders, Google Classroom, or Schoology accounts. Remember that it is essential that students are present and on time each school day. Continuous improvement is only possible when we all work together to support our students.
