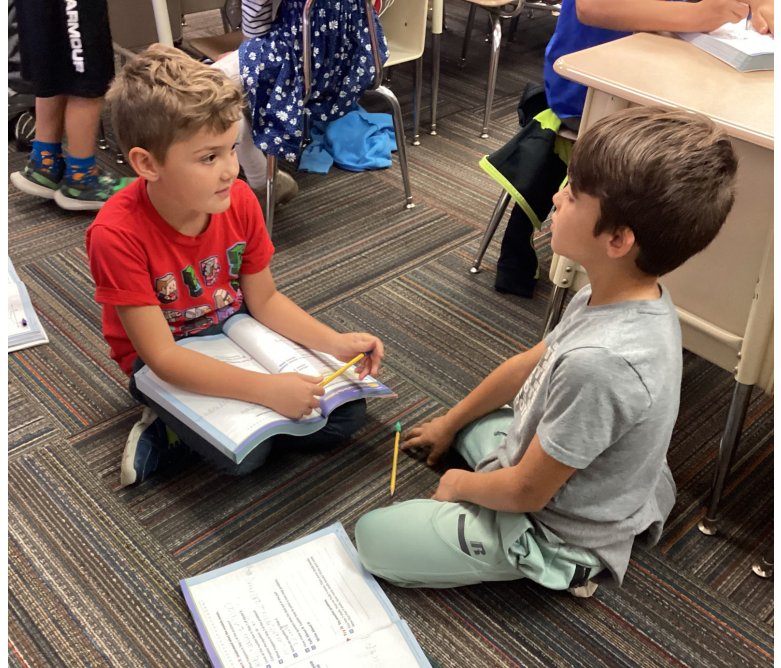

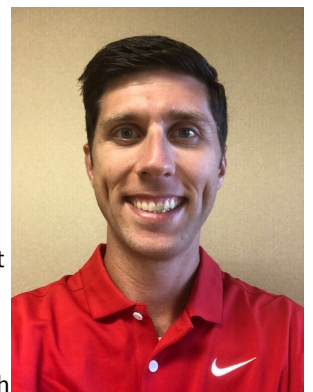
From the Principal **Mr. Heinold**
