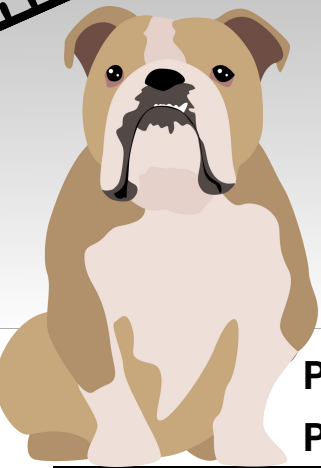

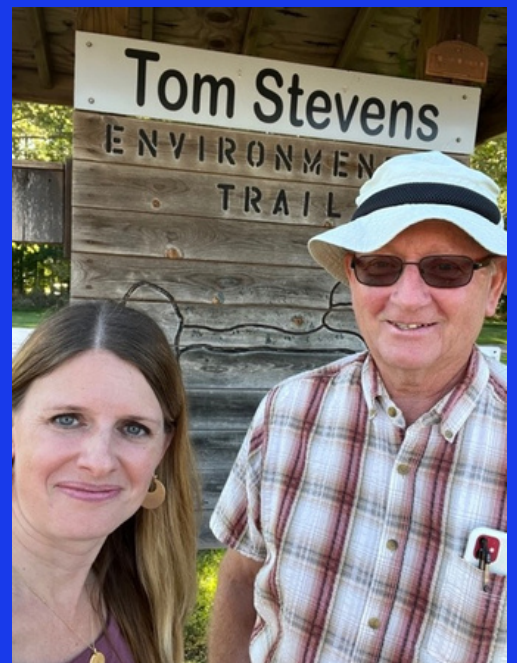
WHAT IS HAPPENING AROUND ROLLING PRAIRIE?
