FAMILY FRIENDLY SCHOOL STUDENT SURVEYS

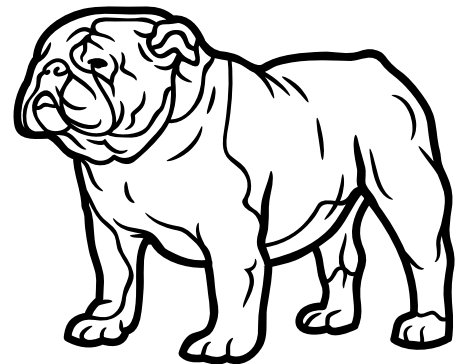
