February 27, 2023

The regular meeting of the School Board was held Monday, February 27, 2023, 6:00 p.m., at the Central Office in the Board Room with Mr. Phil King, Mr. Dale Groves, Mrs. Jill Smith and Mr. Rich Gadacz present. Dr. Paul White, Superintendent, was also present.

Mr. Jason DeMeyer was absent.

Mr. Phil King, Board President, reviewed guidelines for speaking on agenda items.

INSTRUCTIONAL PRESENTATION

- NPHS HOSA Team representatives, Jaiden Winters and Avery Mougin, presented a video on using the AED & Sudden Cardiac Awareness. They explained that they have already trained the High School & Middle School staff, Mentors and many students on how to use the AEDs. They also explained that they are actively doing fundraisers to purchase AEDs for the New Carlisle police cars. The students described where all the AED's are located in the schools.
- Dr. White explained that Mrs. Aerts spent the day testifying to the state legislature advocating for a new Indiana bill that would require AED's to be placed in all schools within 3 minutes of all band and athletic practices and games. Dr. White stated that he is proud to have had Mrs. Aerts as a major part of that conversation at the State House. Mrs. Aerts has also been very active in helping all of our schools become Heart Safe Certified. Rolling Prairie Elementary and New Prairie Middle Schools now are certified along with our High School. Dr. White concluded by thanking Mrs. Aerts and the students for presenting this evening.
