Indiana's Learning Evaluation Assessment Readiness Network (ILEARN) is the summative accountability assessment for Indiana students in grades three through eight and high school biology. ILEARN measures student achievement and growth according to Indiana Academic Standards for English/Language Arts for grades three through eight, Mathematics for grades three through eight, Science for grades four and six, and Social Studies for grade five. A student may only have one test attempt for any given ILEARN assessment. There are no retest opportunities available for ILEARN assessments.

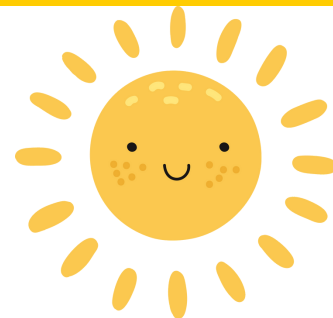
