EXCEPTIONAL LEARNERS SPOTLIGHT

Highlight 1: Lord of the Flies Reading Comprehension

This semester, we read Lord of the Flies with the students. We had some great discussions and activities where they were looking at big ideas like leadership, what happens when things get tough, and how people interact with each other. They were able to utilize critical thinking skills while looking at some pretty deep comprehension questions.

Highlight 2: SAT Prep

We have been putting in some focused work on SAT English and math skills. Through targeted assignments and strategies, the students are building their understanding of key english and math concepts and getting familiar with these types of test questions. The goal is to make them more confident and set them up for success down the road.

Highlight 3: Fast ForWord Reading Program

Our students have been very successful with the Fast ForWord program. It is this cool program that gives each student personalized exercises to help them with reading skills, from hearing sounds to understanding what they read. We are seeing real progress with it, and it is helping our students become stronger and more confident readers in all their classes.

Highlight 4: Journal Reflections

We also do regular journal writing with the students. The prompts are designed to get them thinking about what they are learning, exploring their own ideas and feelings, and just getting their thoughts down on paper. It is also a great way for them to reflect and for us to get to know them!

PE/HEALTH SPOTLIGHT

Big news from the PE department—we've added some awesome new tech to the weight room! We're now using a system called Perch, which uses 3D cameras to track things like bar speed, bar path, power output, and more. Basically, it gives you live feedback on how you're lifting so you can see your progress in real time.

It's a great way for students to set goals, improve technique, and push themselves in a smart, safe way. Whether you're just getting started or already hitting big numbers, Perch helps everyone take their training to the next level.

We're pumped about how it's going so far, and we can't wait to see how it helps our students grow stronger and more confident every day!





AP Exams

From May 5th through May 16th, students enrolled in AP courses will be taking their AP exams.

Scoring well on these exams can save time and money in college!

If your student is taking one or more of these exams in the next two weeks, encourage them to get a good night's rest, eat a healthy breakfast, and remember their training! Students have been preparing all year for these tests.

- The NPHS Graduation Ceremony will be on Sunday, June 1st at 2pm at Amzie Miller Field. Gates will open one hour beforehand. Tickets will not be used for this event. Additional graduation information will be sent directly to Senior families through email.
