"New Prairie administration & school board has made the decision to eliminate the building trades program at the high school for Juniors and Seniors."

This statement is completely false. Not only is the Building Trades program continuing as part of our Career and Technical Education programming, we have actually expanded opportunities in this pathway for students through additional classes, an additional instructor, and resources to meet the demand of students who have interest in a career in this field. The program will continue to build a home in the community and will now offer expanded opportunities for students to earn industry certifications.

NPUSC also recently renewed our articulation agreement with IKORCC in order to provide preapprenticeship & certification programs that connect our students to local trade unions and postsecondary opportunities.
