Content Filtering Disclaimer for NPUSC Virtual Students

This policy applies strictly to NPUSC Virtual Students. Hybrid students on campus remain subject to standard NPUSC filtering and network policies.

Parents/guardians and students acknowledge that when NPUSC-issued devices are used off-campus by Virtual Students, NPUSC's web filtering solution (Securly) may be disabled to allow access to external networks. As a result, NPUSC cannot guarantee the same level of content filtering or online protection provided on district networks. Internet access in these cases will be subject solely to the filtering and security controls of the external network.

NPUSC shall not be held responsible for:

- Monitoring or managing internet activity when devices are used off-campus.
- Providing or producing device browsing history, location data, or other activity records generated while connected to non-NPUSC networks.
- Any data exposure, access to inappropriate material, or network activity occurring outside of NPUSC's managed environment.
- Any damages, losses, or liabilities arising from device use on non-NPUSC networks.

Parents/guardians further agree that:

- All NPUSC-issued devices remain the property of NPUSC and must be returned in accordance with district policy.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for supervising safe and appropriate use of NPUSC-issued devices when used off-campus.
- All NPUSC Acceptable Use Policies (AUP) and the Student Code of Conduct remain in effect for device use, regardless of location.
- Parents/guardians agree to indemnify and hold harmless NPUSC, its employees, and its agents from any claims, damages, or liabilities resulting from use of NPUSC-issued devices on non-NPUSC networks.
