- 6. Currently, the only graduation pathway available through Indiana Online is Business -Finance. Students would need to take Principles of Business Management, Personal Finance and Banking, and Finance and Investment before graduation.
- 7. For core courses (English, math, science, social studies), students can receive synchronous (LIVE) instruction from their teacher following a master schedule. Attendance will be required at these sessions. Students can opt to take these classes asynchronously (students complete coursework at their own pace/guided by a pacing guide) instead.
- 8. All electives and higher-level core courses (AP, Dual Credit) will be delivered **asynchronously**, but with an Indiana Online teacher leading the course. Attendance at a set time is not required for these sessions, but active participation is required.
- LIVE classes meet Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. <u>WIN Wednesday</u> is for RTI, if needed.
- 10. Students enrolled in the online program are eligible to participate in extracurricular activities offered by New Prairie. Students enrolled in the online program can participate in IHSAA athletics but will be required to attend at least one in-person class on campus, as mandated by the IHSAA.

- 11. Special Education services are also available for students with an IEP.
- 12. Master schedule for LIVE instruction if you choose that option.
- 13. You may opt out after one full semester.
- 14. Out-of-district students will need to find their own transportation to and from school.
